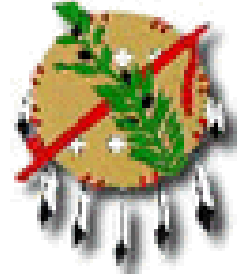

ARCHITECTING HEURISTICS FOR SYSTEMS ENGINEERING MANAGEMENT AND EMBEDDED SYSTEMS ENGINEERING

This month Mark Anderson, Senior Manager of Quality Assurance and Quality Control for Boeing Company will be our guest speaker. The topic will cover software development for United States weapon systems. This is a "right here, right now" prize captured by those who must rapidly develop requirements and deliver a quality product.

Mark Anderson is the Senior Manager of Quality Assurance and Quality Control for the Boeing Company B-1 and B-2 bomber software avionics programs in Oklahoma City. He received this position in July 2008 after attaining over 10 years of experience in systems engineering, requirements development, and test analysis. Prior to his employment at Boeing, Mark served in the United States Air Force as a senior navigator with career broadening assignments as a software acquisition manager; and an electronic warfare engineering and test squadron operations officer. Mark's Air Force career highlight was serving as a flight evaluator and instructor for the first operational crew force and combat crew training squadron for the B-1 weapon system. During his USAF career he accumulated over 1000 flight hours as a B-1 weapons systems officer; and over 1500 flight hours as B-52 electronic warfare officer.

Mark has a Masters of Science in Systems Engineering from Missouri University of Science and Technology (MS&T, formerly the University of Missouri – Rolla). In 1999 he received a Masters of Arts in Computer Resource Management and Information Systems from Webster University. He was a Regent's Scholar at the University of California – Riverside where he received a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science.
