"Fighting Hunger...Feeding Hope"

Our guest speaker this month will be Bill McKnight, Director of Operations at the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma. For the past 5 years Bill has been leading the way in their fight against hunger. There is no doubt that 29 years of experience with Fleming Foods helped to prepare him for this challenge!

The Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma is a private, 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that acts as a link through which the food industry and community may donate food and other goods. The products are then distributed to nearly 500 charitable feeding programs in 53 central and western Oklahoma counties. In the last fiscal year, the Food Bank distributed **24 million** pounds of food and product to help the charitable community effectively feed people in need. Since its inception in 1980, the Food Bank has distributed **260 million** pounds of food to feed Oklahoma's hungry.

During the first year, the Food Bank distributed approximately 280,000 pounds of food to 45 charities – Now they do that in 3½ days. The Food Bank has modeled its distribution facility after those developed by the commercial food industry, by delivering food in both rural and urban areas in a manner that meets the increasing needs of those struggling to put food on their table. As the Food Bank has continued to grow, it has refined its distribution systems and has assisted food banks in other states with facility development and model programs.

Please join us as we learn more about this amazing organization and how they have worked to continually improve their processes to become the largest private hunger-relief charity in Oklahoma
