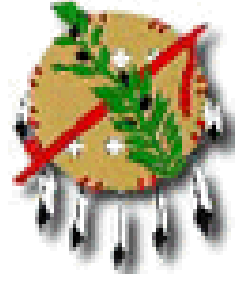

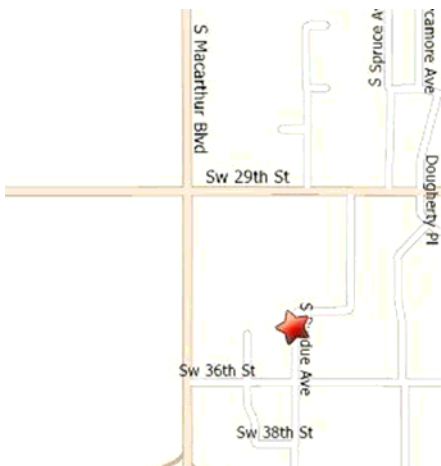

The Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma is located just north of Will Rogers World Airport in Oklahoma City at 3355 S. Purdue. **Come in at the front entrance.**

Follow S. MacArthur Ave. to SW 36th Street and turn left. Once on SW 36th Street, take the second left-hand turn onto Purdue. The Food Bank is the fourth building on the left.



Tour:

Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma

Nearly 500,000 people are at risk of going hungry each day in Oklahoma. Since its founding in 1980, the mission of the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma has been to help the charitable community effectively feed people in need.

The Regional Food Bank is the largest private hunger relief organization in Oklahoma. Through a network of more than 500 charitable agencies, the Food Bank distributes 24 million pounds of food each year which feeds just over 244,500 people. These agencies include homeless shelters, soup kitchens, mobile meals programs, senior citizen's centers, children's centers, and food pantries.

On the tour, guests will see the entire distribution center and learn where the food comes from, how we get it ready to ship, and whom it helps. They will hear stories of real people that have benefitted from receiving help from the Food Bank and learn how they can join in the fight against hunger in Oklahoma.
